The Queensland Government offers **Free Apprenticeships for Under 25s** for select priority qualifications. This means eligible students **won't pay student contribution fees** for those courses.

Important Information:

- Pricing applies only to Traineeship and Apprenticeship enrolments through CTA Training Specialists in Queensland.
- The Co-contribution fees are set by the Department at \$1.60 per nominal hour for each Unit of competency selected on the training plan. Units processed as credits transferred are not charged for.
- Adjustments to the Co-Contribution fee may be applied annually and will be made solely by the Department.
- Full enrolment details, including our refund policy, are outlined in the Student Handbook and available at our offices.
- Additional Co-Contribution fees may be charged to the employer; and will be negotiated and agreed upon before the apprentice or trainee commences.
